

# Ofex hears Sound Alert loud and clear

SHARES in **Sound Alert Technology** rose 4p to 28.5p on Ofex yesterday on hopes that its patented product for helping people to detect from which direction sound is coming will start to generate revenues now that it has been licensed to Channel Safety Systems.

Sound Alert has developed a

sequence of sounds – known as the Localiser – which enables the human ear to accurately locate the direction from which the sound emanates.

When it is incorporated in a range of evacuation systems, it can assist in the location of exit routes where confusion exists or where vision may be impaired.

The company announced last Thursday that Channel Safety Systems has been licensed to incorporate the technology into its range of emergency lighting and fire detection equipment.

Elsewhere on Ofex, **Zardah Separation** gained 0.5p to 2.75p. Its shares resumed trading

last week after a six-month suspension period. Gold exploration firm **Twiggs Minerals** closed 2.5p higher at 22p.

Meanwhile, shares in **Rangers** were unchanged at 230p.
